Art Workshop Instructor:

When: August 2021-June 2022, Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays

Qualifications: must have a background in fine arts, at least one year experience teaching art to youth, ability to manage youth aged 11-14, ability to implement up to two varieties of techniques (for example: drawing, painting, watercolor) each semester, ability to adapt to program requirements and needs

Choir Workshop Instructor:

When: August 2021-June 2022, Tuesdays and Thursdays

Qualifications: must have a background in music and choir, at least one year experience teaching youth of all skill levels, ability to manage youth aged 11-14, lead efforts in training singers of all levels, prepare students for winter and spring showcases, ability to adapt to program requirements and needs

Dance Workshop Instructor:

When: August 2021-June 2022, Mondays and Wednesdays

Qualifications: must have a background in international dances and/or hip-hop, at least one year experience teaching to youth, ability to manage youth aged 11-14, ability to adapt to program requirements and needs

Karate Workshop Instructor

When: August 2021-June 2022, Tuesdays and Thursdays

Qualifications: must have a background in karate, at least one year experience teaching youth, tailored to the skill level of enrolled students, including new techniques, use of pads or heavy bags, sparring, meditation, stretching, conditioning, and discussing the history philosophy of the art, ability to manage youth aged 11-14, ability to adapt to program requirements and needs

All workshop instructors are considered independent contractors and are required to undergo a criminal background check, in addition to providing proof of a negative TB test within the last six months. Class sessions will not be held during school holidays or dates not included in the LAUSD school calendar.
